Job Description:

Flexible schedule summer teaching. Teach a range of styles and repertoire. Opportunity to teach piano in UVMC's Suzuki program for a qualified candidate.

Qualifications:

Experience teaching students of all ages, but must be comfortable teaching beginning and intermediate children and adults (ages 5 and up). Regular activity as a performing musician and/or teacher. Music degree highly desirable. Candidate must be committed to teaching and to students' successful learning. Good communication skills, teamwork and willingness to help develop UVMC programming essential.
